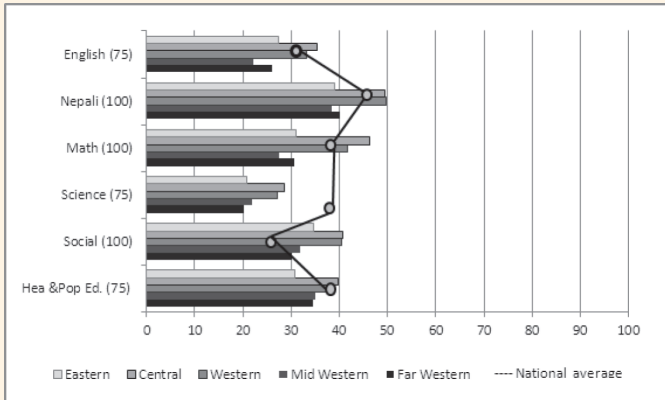

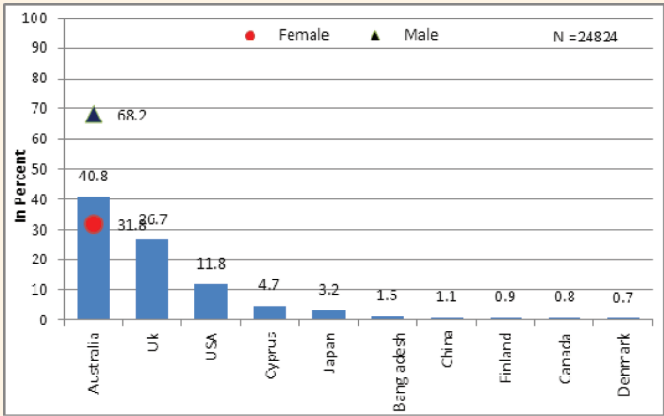

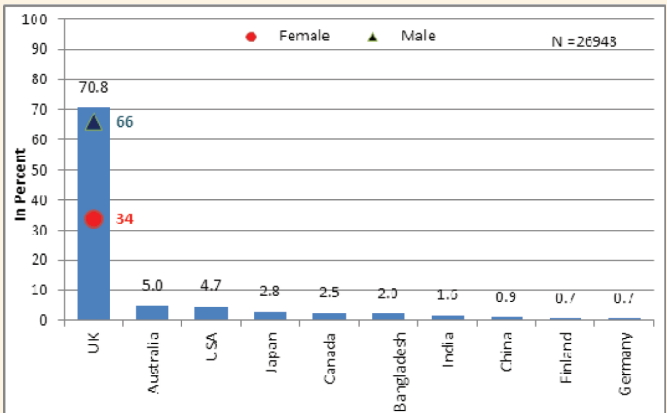

a. Top Ten Destinations studying abroad in the FY 2065/66

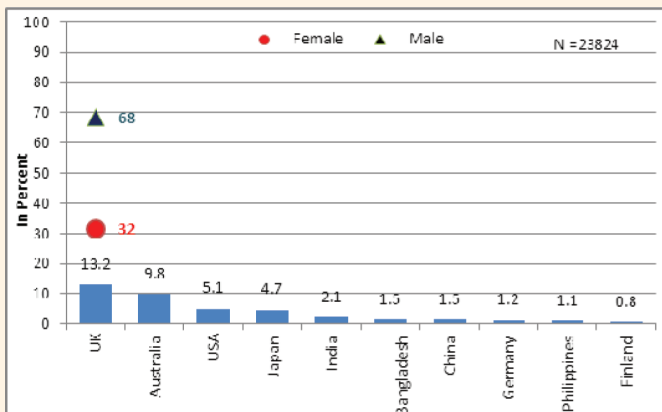

b. Top Ten Destinations studying abroad in the FY 2066/67

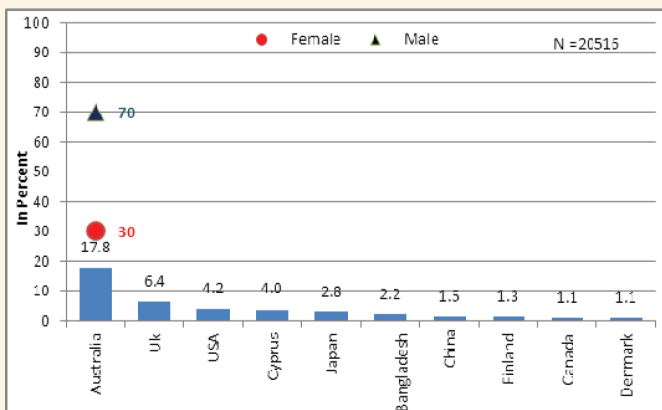


c. Top Ten Destinations in the FY 2067/04/01 to 2068/03/31



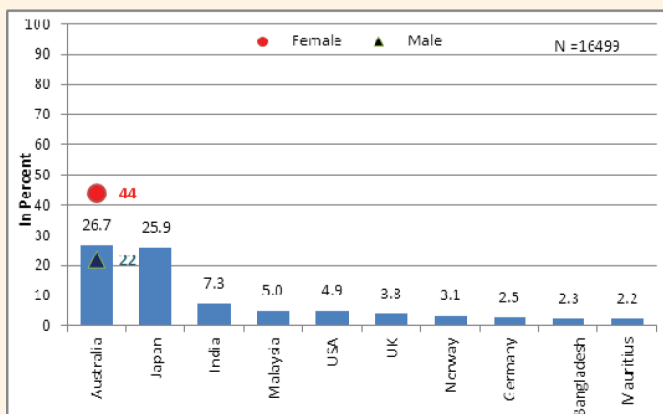
